After a long career working in all facets of the TV and film industry, she is now helping others through her business, Healing My Skin, LLC. She is an International Certified Holistic Health Coach, Psoriasis Expert, Speaker, and Author.

Naomi Cunningham, Comprehensive Adolescent Pregnancy Program Manager, Planned Parenthood

Naomi Cunningham received a Master's degree in Community Health Promotion from Adelphi University. Naomi currently manages the NYS Department of Health funded Comprehensive Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention (CAPP) program housed at Planned Parenthood of Nassau County. Naomi provides both youth and adults with reproductive healthcare outreach and educational programming that is culturally sensitive, medically accurate and age-appropriate.

Cindy Reide Combs, LMSW, Social Worker, Brentwood School District

Cindy Reide Combs is a social worker employed by Brentwood Schools for 22 years. She serves as a faculty field liaison at Adelphi University and is an instructor for CORE Professional Development. Her work has focused on parent education, female empowerment, diversity training and veterans. Cindy's accolades include Field Educator of the Year by Adelphi University. She has been honored by Islip Town for Women's History Month; the Suffolk Network on Adolescent Pregnancy; Brookhaven Town for Black History Month and The Butterfly Effect Project.

Chelsea Kronengold, MA, Senior Program Associate, National Eating Disorders Association

Chelsea Kronengold is a body image and eating disorders advocate and nonprofit professional. Presently, Chelsea is a senior program associate at NEDA playing an essential role with NEDA's prevention efforts by training and disseminating the Body Project; an evidence-based body confidence program for women and girls. Chelsea frequently speaks on behalf of NEDA about her personal and professional experience with body image, eating disorders, media literacy, and weight stigma; she has appeared in national media platforms including Teen Vogue, Huffington Post Live, Seventeen Magazine, and WebMD.

Shannon R. Lane, LMSW, PH.D. Sacred Heart University

Shannon serves as an Associate Professor in social work at Sacred Heart University, and was previously Associate Professor at Adelphi University School of Social Work. Her research includes efforts to increase the political involvement of social workers and underserved populations. She leads the research committee at the Humphreys Institute for Political Social Work at the University of Connecticut, and is a member of the Council on the Status and Role of Women in Social Work Education, and the advisory board of the Congressional Research Institute for Social Work and Policy (CRISP).
